Voice Your Choice offers free tools and materials to facilitate advance care planning discussions and help your patients complete or upload an existing digital advance care plan making it easier to find in an emergency. The program offers detailed, no-cost webinars and online resources to educate patients about advance care planning and the importance of choosing a health care agent. The webinars also provide a step-by-step process to support the creation of a digital advance care plan. The utilized online tool is integrated with CRISP making completed plans easier to find during a healthcare crisis. Voice Your Choice also offers support for providers in the “Advance Care Planning Resources for the COVID-19 Pandemic” handout.
